MOTION TO APPROVE FUNDS FOR REPEATER EQUIPMENT PURCHASE

As VE3RB has proven to be a high performing repeater, that gets county wide coverage, and the equipment is on loan, we would like to move forward with purchase of equipment to make VE3RB a permanent PARC Resource.

We originally got a quote back in March for used Multicouplers for \$3000 plus tax. However thanks to the hard work of Martin VA3OMW, and the tech team we have managed to source a much more cost effective deal. Only because we are a club, a vendor in north york has agreed to sell us the equipment we need at a heavy discount.

We will purchase used equipment from the vendor in North York, the pricing is as follows:

1x Motorola MTR3000 100w VHF Repeater (to replace the identical one at RB) **\$1500**
2x Sinclair VHF Multicouplers (2 Set per repeater) \$250 per set, total **\$500**
2x Bandpass Filter Cavity (reduce noise floor at VE3PBO) \$25 each, total **\$50**
1x Motorola MTR2000 40w VHF Repeater (Reliable Spare Repeater) **\$500**
2x 2 Post Equipment Rack \$50 Each, total **\$100**

Total Purchase \$2650

Last time we got a report on the fundraising program total there has been \$2000 donated by individual members, that \$2000 has been matched by an anonymous donor, so we currently have \$4000 in the club accounts for this project.

As we are getting the multicouplers, Repeater, and an extra repeater for less than the original quoted price for multicouplers this is an excellent deal.
