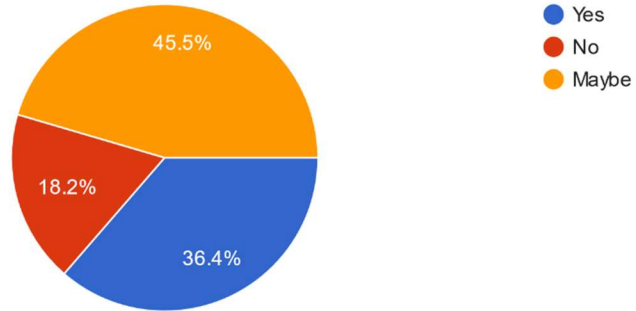

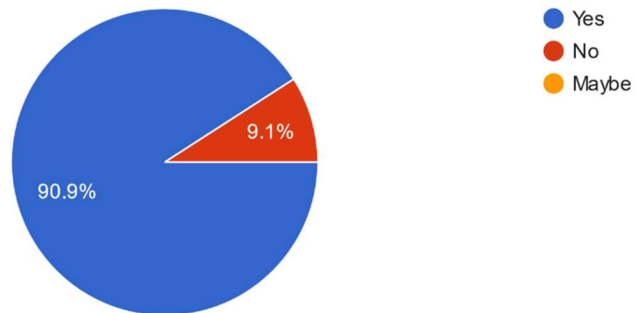
Are you willing to be a designated Elmer?

Are you interested in attending training workshops

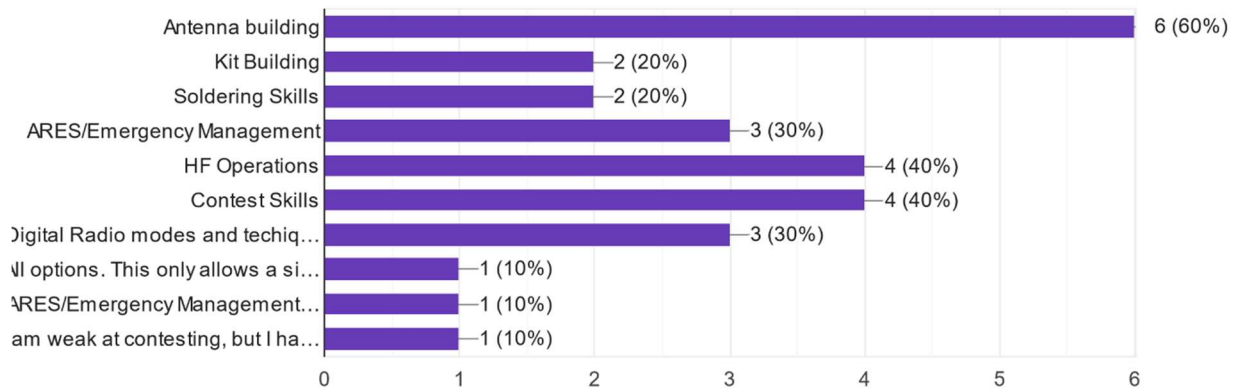

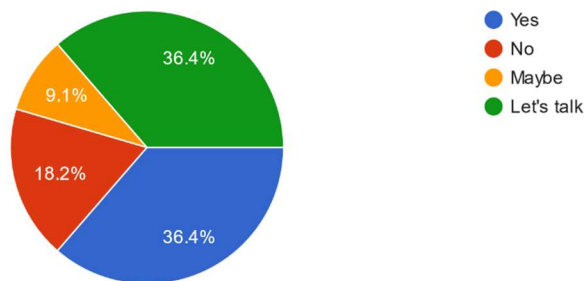
### What Workshops are of interest?
