We will be releasing the draft before the end of the month for the club to review and comment before forwarding it to the lawyer. As the deadline is mid october we are hoping to get everything ready for a special meeting at the October General Meeting.

We are asking the club to approve up to \$1000 for lawyers fees for these changes.

PETERBOROUGH AMATEUR RADIO CLUB MOTION TO APPROVE NEW VE3TZM REPEATER

As we have purchased a Motorola 40 Watt MTR2000 we are planning to replace the Yaesu Wires-X Capable DR-1X Repeater at VE3TJR with the MTR2000. We will then have an extra DR-1X Repeater. Currently we have access to a UHF Antenna at the Baltimore VE3BUY Site the only thing that is using it currently is the VE3BUY-10 Winlink Node.

Clay Youmans has offered to purchase and loan the club: 3 UHF Multicouplers 1 HRI-200 Wires-X Interface

We are proposing that we multicouple the spare DR-1X repeater into the UHF antenna at Baltimore and use the existing PC that is there to run the Wires-X Software and link this new repeater to VA3PBO via Wires-X. This will move forward the original intention with the purchase of the DR-1X repeaters and increase Yaesu System Fusion Coverage in our area.

With Barry VE3BLM's permission we are proposing this new repeater operate as VE3TZM to honor Teresa who became a silent key in 2022.

This motion is to approve the new VE3TZM Repeater.
