I have purchased two MTR2000 repeaters, and will donate them to the club under the following conditions:

- 1. Should the repeaters no longer be needed by the club (be replaced by new equipment or otherwise) I will decide what will be done with them (sell them, or to be kept as spares, or return them to me)
- 2. Should the club ever cease to exist they will be returned to me.

Included with both repeaters is an interface for allstar.

I have two different types and the plan for them is as followed:

40 Watt VHF Repeater

Motorola MTR2000 SN: 474CDT0049

Will replace the 25 watt Icom repeater currently at BUY providing almost double the power at the site and increased reliability. The ICOM repeater at the Baltimore site's easy front panel access makes it well suited to be the club's easy swappable spare repeater.

100 Watt VHF Repeater

Motorola MTR2000 SN: 474CMF0022

Will replace the Yaesu DR-1X at VE3APL. As many of you may have noticed, the APL repeater works very well receiving everything, however most of the time we cannot hear it.

The DR-1X will be kept as a spare for now for the 2 Wires-X repeaters we have in use. Unless we can find a suitable location for it to run in Digital.
