As we require a motion to make any major modifications to PARC equipment. Many of you have probably noticed, the sound of VE3RB currently is not as full sounding as the rest of the network. This is due to the repeater a Motorola MTR3000 being designed for digital and not analogue. Since I donated a 100 watt MTR2000 for VE3APL which is the previous generation equivalent to the MTR3000 at RB, and better sounding. I propose that we swap the MTR2000 in for RB and use the MTR3000 at APL. This work can be done when we install the remote power control device, and will give the Technical Committee some time to see if they can improve the sound quality of the MTR3000.
